



DIOCESAN FUEL AND HUNGER FUND: Incarnation's Outreach ministry has received \$4,200 from the Diocesan Fuel and Hunger Grant for 2017. JUSTICE CORNER: Several years ago, IMPACT took on the problem of youth unemployment, and through the efforts of all our congregations, we got a pilot program training young adults to become CNAs. Now, the program is in full swing, with 95% of participants graduating, and it is going to expand next year. Justice work impacts more people's lives than charity.

GREEN TEAM EnvironMINUTE: 40% of America's food ends up in the trash. Really appreciate the gifts God gives us by buying less and making sure you use produce and other food before it goes bad.

FOOD MINISTRY-INVITATION: For our food ministry to function, we need people in a variety of roles. Currently, we are looking for help with Saturday pickups from Trader Joe's, usually a two hour commitment.
