


40 DAYS FOR LIFE: Every **Tuesday** in October from 4:00-5:00 pm, **Youth Ministry** has committed to being present outside of

DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals): Free DACA renewal appointments are available on Friday, September 29 from 9:00am to 4:00pm at the Legal Aid Justice Center (1000 Preston Avenue, Charlottesville). To make an appointment and learn what you need to bring with you, call 434-529-1811. Walk-ins are also welcome. **1.** DACA authorizations and work permits expiring between now and March 5, 2018 must be submitted for renewal by October 5, 2017. **2.** Your DACA is valid until its expiration date. DACA and work permits (Employment Authorization Documents) will remain valid until their expiration date. To determine when your DACA and work permit expire, look at your I-795 Approval Notice and the bottom of your Employment Authorization Document (EAD). **3.** No new DACA applications will be accepted. United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) no longer will accept or process first-time applications as of September 5, 2017. **4.** Advance Parole to travel abroad is no longer available.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: As brothers and sisters in Christ, we take care of each other. You may be aware that some of the money that is given for "Outreach" every month goes to help parishioners in need. If you are a registered parishioner, and you are struggling with rent, electricity, or another essential bill, talk to Sheila in the Parish Office to see if the church can help.



IMPACT SACRED CONVERSATIONS: As God's children, we are all invited to participate in the justice work of our faith by inviting the outcasts to our banquet. Before we get to the Annual Assembly in October, we each have a chance to share stories of the people we know who have felt cast aside.
