



Openings are still available for the 2014 Litnic season! Litnics are a venerable Incarnation summer tradition; they are *Liturgic picnics*, and here's how they work.

Someone who wants to host a litnic calls the parish office and signs up for one of the posted available dates. They receive parish guidelines for hosting a litnic which must be read carefully. Litnics are particularly intended for Catholics in the host's neighborhood, but all parishioners are invited to litnics. **JUNE 20 IS WORLD REFUGEE DAY:** Virginia has the 7<sup>th</sup> highest rate of human trafficking in the US, which can affect both domestic and international victims.
