



### **PRAYER SERVICE FOR PEACE AND SOLIDARITY**



In recent times, our world has been overrun with tragedy, and the response has too frequently focused on fear and hate. From violence in our own country, violence internationally, and the current political situation, it can feel like we are unable to make a meaningful response. As Catholics, we are called to respond to the situation around us, with both in words and concrete actions. Please come on Monday night, August 1 at 6:30pm to pray for our world. If you would like, bring something to place on the altar as a prayer intention or in thanksgiving for positive things you have seen in recent weeks.



In this *Year of Mercy*, we marvel at how God's mercy breaks in to the lives of ordinary people in good times and in crisis. That is what we see in the films that we view and discuss at our parish **TNT (Theater 'N' Theology)**. Our next TNT takes place on *Friday, August 5*, beginning promptly at 7:00pm. All are welcome to come to our **Incarnation Movie Theater** (the "Stone Chapel") with comfortable seating and large projection. After the movie (the "Theology" part), we discuss the film's relevance to our life in Christ and note the action of God's mercy. Our August feature is the 1996 film **Marvin's Room**. It is an affecting adaptation of Scott McPherson's off-Broadway play about a woman who's devoted her adult life to caring for her stroke-ridden father and a dithery aunt; now she must call on her long-estranged sister and nephews to help out in her own health emergency. It is a poignant and pointed look at family ties, old wounds, love, and responsibility, with uniformly fine performances. Hume Cronyn adds immeasurable strength, though he says not a word. Rachel Portman's beautiful score is another asset. Also starring Meryl Streep, Leonardo DiCaprio, Diane Keaton, Robert De Niro, and Gwen Verdon. Rated PG-13. Facilitated by Fr. Gregory.
