October will mark the canonization of one of the great popes of modern times, Paul VI. At our next TNT (Theater 'N' Theology) on *Friday, August 17*, beginning promptly at 7:00pm, all are welcome to come to our **Incarnation Movie Theater** (the "Stone Chapel") with comfortable seating and large projection, to view Part II of *Paul VI: The Pope in the Tempest*, an Italian film from 2008. From 1963 to 1978 the papacy of Pope Paul VI helped shape how the Catholic Church would confront the complexities of the modern world. This beautifully produced film, covering 50 years of history that changed the Catholic Church and the world, is a story that draws its lessons and emotional resonance from history itself, dramatically mixing stunning reconstructions and real, historical film footage. In Part I, in July, we watched the story of Pope Paul's life up until the time he was chosen as Pope in the Conclave of 1963; in Part II, we will see the story of Pope Paul's eventful 15 years in the Chair of Peter. Opportunities to GROW in Faith

Did you know that as an alternative to our regular Christian Formation classes that occur on Sundays from mid September through the end of April, we offer an intergenerational program called FIRE here at Incarnation that is open to all. **Family Intergenerational Religious Education (F.I.R.E.)** is done in small groups and based out of homes. Groups decide when and in what homes they will meet to complete approximately 16 lessons during the school year. Rather than dropping kids at several different class times on Sunday, everyone attends the same meeting at a time that's convenient for the whole family.

FIRE is meant to be fun, for you, for your family, and for your group as you explore the experience of being "church" for each other and grow in closeness to the Lord.
