**AN ENCOUNTER WITH THE LORD JESUS**

**Where does this encounter take place?** This encounter takes place in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel every *Thursday* from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Here our Eucharistic Lord is exposed in Adoration.

Sometimes because of our busyness it's not easy to be present. But it's good to remember....that the Lord is here, the rest of the week. The Lord Jesus is present in the tabernacle and he awaits our visit. If our church is open.....the Blessed Sacrament Chapel is open. Our chapel is so inviting in its simplicity: a lighted candle hangs to remind us that Jesus' Divine Majesty is present. This very simple wooden box, the Tabernacle, tells of the humanity of Jesus, our Brother, our Savior and our Lord. On the wall besides the tabernacle hangs the icon of the Holy Trinity.

In visiting the Blessed Sacrament Chapel all that is necessary is a respectful and prayerful silence. No special prayers, no set time....no appointments are necessary. We come there to praise the Lord Jesus and to thank him for all his blessings. There are days we come when we are sad and worried....but there are also days when we come to share our joy and happiness. But never forget, as with a good visit to friends....o let Jesus speak to you. Let Jesus guide you, inspire you, console you and remind you how much he loves you.

If you come to visit the Lord Jesus in his Eucharistic Presence...you will notice a change for the better in your life!

Although there are similar ministries and programs supported by both the *Living Our Mission* campaign and the Annual Appeal, there is a distinct difference. The *Living Our Mission* campaign was a historic first-time effort to build major endowments and capital to support our parishes and larger Church leading into the future. Although many projects were realized in the short-term, the vast majority of funds raised were designed for the **future**. In contrast, the Annual Diocesan Appeal is initiated every year to meet ministry and program needs of the **present**. While the *Living Our Mission* campaign was an overwhelming success and set our Church up for a strong financial future, the Annual Appeal is still a very necessary component of meeting our goals in the short-term. That is why we are asking for your prayerful support of a pledge or gift to the 2017 Annual Appeal.

An important aspect of the Appeal is that all parishes receive back a portion of their funds collected to be used for important local priorities. This year, the funds returned to our parish will be deposited into our Maintenance Reserve Fund.
