**NONVIOLENCE WORKSHOP: SAVE THE DATE!** We are happy to host Laurie and John Gagne for a talk about nonviolence on Saturday, March 10. This event will be held in conjunction with Casa Alma, and will have lots of ways to interact and learn. More details to come in the next few weeks!

**GREEN TEAM EnvironMINUTE:** Sometimes our society prioritizes money and profit over the care for creation and our common home. As Catholics, we are called to stand up and make our voices heard through advocacy, especially when policies are being advanced that hurt nature.

**JUSTICE CORNER:** 53% of the Charlottesville population, excluding students, rents their housing. Of those, 48.7% are cost-burdened according to HUD. That means that people or struggling to pay for food, utilities, debts, and other essentials because of the lack of housing in our city. Come to our Justice and Peace mass and network meeting at 6:00pm on February 28 to learn more about how to get involved!

**SHARE THE JOURNEY** The US bishops are very supportive of those who have received DACA (or Dreamer) status over the last six years. These are young people brought to the US when they were still children, who have been allowed to live, work, and go to school here under an executive order. There are many Dreamers in our own parish, who are currently worried their status may be revoked. Please advocate with your congressional representatives to save DACA in some form!
