



**IMPACT SACRED CONVERSATIONS:** As God's children, we are all invited to participate in the justice work of our faith by inviting the outcasts to our banquet. Before we get to the Annual Assembly in October, we each have a chance to share stories of the people we know who have felt cast aside. These are our Sacred Conversations, or House Meetings. Justice Ministry team members will be calling people they know to invite them to one of these conversations over the next several weeks. **COMPOST BIN:** You may have noticed Incarnation's new compost bin in the community garden! We are hoping to reduce our waste stream and protect God's creation by composting our food waste. **FOOD MINISTRY-INVITATION:** For our food ministry to function, we need people in a variety of roles.
