A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Nancy Brinkac, our outstanding Coordinator of Christian Formation, retired on June 18. Beginning on July 1, Patrick Drury, presently our Youth Minister, will become our Director of Christian Formation, assisted by John Kronstain, who will join our parish staff as part-time Coordinator of Youth Ministry. Beginning August 2, Lori Brodhead will join our staff as part-time Coordinator of Children's Ministries. Patrick, John, and Lori will work as a team to continued to provide excellent Christian Formation to all children, youth, and adults in our parish.



Litnics are a venerable Incarnation summer tradition; they are *Liturgy picnics*, and here's how they work. It is located on a 16 acre parcel of land directly opposite the Church on Rt. 29 South. There is an interesting historic Loving Gap cemetery located on this land with graves going back to the late 1800's. Some of the Loving Family, for whom Lovington is named, are buried there. They have approximately 240 grave sites available and are offering them at an initial rate of \$500 per grave site until the end of June, as of July 1, the price will increase to \$1,000 per grave.
