

**DIOCESAN FUEL AND HUNGER FUND:** Incarnation's Outreach ministry has received \$4,200 from the Diocesan Fuel and Hunger Grant for 2017. We are grateful to the diocese, and grateful to be able to continue caring for the material needs of our parishioners, both through food ministry and through emergency financial assistance.



**COFFEE AND CONVERSATIONS:** On Sunday, we will have another chance to get together with our diverse parish community through Coffee and Conversations.
