**IMPACT Sacred Conversations:** As God's children, we are all invited to participate in the justice work of our faith by inviting the outcasts to our banquet. Before we get to the Annual Assembly in October, we each have a chance to share stories of the people we know who have felt cast aside. These are our Sacred Conversations, or House Meetings. Justice Ministry team members will be calling people they know to invite them to one of these conversations over the next several weeks. This week, our hosts are Fr, Gregory and Tom Eckman on Tuesday, Janie Pudhorodsky on Wednesday, and Janie Eckman on Thursday. 
