“What to expect for public Mass”

Before You Arrive	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sign Up each member of your family to attend Mass (link on our website) 2. Plan to arrive 30-minutes prior to the Mass you signed up to attend 3. Use the restroom before arriving – facilities at the Church have strict protocols and guidelines
Parking	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Follow the directions of the parking attendants 2. Park in every other spot, leaving an empty space between vehicles 3. Maintain social distance in the parking lot
Entering the Church	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Anyone over 3-years-old must wear a face covering (gloves are also strongly encouraged) 2. Maintain social distance (6 ft.) using the floor markers as a reference 3. One person from each household approaches the check-in table when called forward 4. Answer, honestly, the three questions asked by the greeters/ushers 5. Receive your seat ticket and proceed to the Worship Center entrance
Seating	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sit in the assigned seat(s) that matches the ticket given to you by the greeter/usher (there will be signs taped to the back of the pews)
During Mass	<p><u>Singing</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Refrain from singing at this time. <p><u>Offertory</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You may continue to contribute electronically or bring your offering with you to the Communion table (baskets will be provided on the tables) <p><u>Communion</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Wait to be called up by an usher and maintain social distance (6 ft.) at all times 2. We strongly encourage you to only receive in the hand at this time 3. Once you receive Communion: step to the side, remove your mask, consume, refit your mask, and return to your seat

Sending Forth	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Wait for an usher to dismiss your row2. Maintain social distancing (6 ft.) while exiting3. Go directly to your vehicle, following exit patterns marked on the floor
Additional Considerations	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. You must wear a face covering at all times except when receiving Communion2. Maintain social distance (6 ft.) at all times3. The use of hand sanitizer is strongly recommended whenever possible4. Do not attend Mass if you or someone in your household answers “yes” to one of the following questions:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have you or anyone in your household had a fever in the past two (2) weeks?• Do you or anyone in your household have a new cough or new shortness of breath?• Have you come into contact with anyone who is positive with COVID-19 in the past two (2) weeks?
Reporting Symptoms or Positive COVID-19 Test Results	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. If you begin to experience symptoms associated with COVID-19 within 48 hours of having attended Mass, contact the Parish Office2. If you receive a positive COVID-19 test result and have attended Mass within the past 14 days, contact the Parish Office
